5) Eligibility:

The candidate must have passed 10 + 2 or equivalent examination including International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB certificate / & D.P. awarded candidates are not eligible) with science or science vocational with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM) or Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) and English as compulsory subjects and obtained minimum **45% marks in (PCM/PCB)**.

Those awaiting their 10+2 exam result this year may also apply.

Admission will be based on any CET score. If seats remain vacant after admitting CET candidate the Non CET candidate will be admitted on the basis of 10 + 2 or equivalent exam marks of PCM/PCB

5.1 Note (for IB & Cambridge Candidate):

Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who do not have final mark sheet will be given "Provisional Admission" based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet if found eligible before the commencement of the programme.

5.2 Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they required minimum cut off marks and should be eligible & produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the stipulated time.

- 5.3 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, must produce in writing from the concerned Board/University about the equivalent percentage for the GPA obtained.
- 5.4 Only single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed in one attempt is mandatory, no compartmentalized mark sheet is consideration
- 5.5 Duplicate registration will not be considered to be eligible for the programme.
- 5.6 Candidates of CBSE, ICSE should mention in the online registration / e-admission form (if selected) 10 + 2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all the subjects for which the candidate has appeared. (Not best of four, five, six or seven).
- 5.7 The candidate shall have passed all the subjects appeared for in the applicable examination/s. the aggregate percentage of all subjects for which the candidate has appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program at the time of admission.
- 5.8 IB Candidate has to enter 'Predicted Score' in case of final grades/marks are not declared. The Admission will be given on Provisional basis only. In case of Foreign Board, candidate has to submit AIU at the time of admission if selected.
- 5.9 In any stage if it is found that the 12th marks & CET score given by candidate in online form is different, such candidate admission will be cancelled & fees will be forfeited.
- 5.10 Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college, failing which candidate will not be admitted.
- 5.11 Candidates passing 10+2 or equivalent from Open or Distance Learning (ODL) school recognized by National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) he / she can apply for any program by fulfilling the eligibility of the program.
- 5.12 It is sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess necessary and requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS.

- 7) Selection Process:

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of CET score & the preferences given by the candidate at the time of online registration.
- Preferences once given in online registration will not be changed later.
- The merit list will be put up on the NMIMS website as per important dates. The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- Candidates who have not appeared for CET may also apply subject to availability of seats.
- If seats remain vacant after admitting CET candidate then Non CET candidate will be admitted on the basis of 10 + 2 or equivalent exam marks of PCM/PCB & the preferences given by the candidate at the time of Online registration.
- Preferences once given in online registration will not be changed later.

Note: Merit list for Non CET candidates will be declared, if required & for vacant seats only.
