5) **Eligibility Criteria (fulfilling all / applicable conditions mandatory)**

- The candidate must have passed 10 + 2 or equivalent exam including International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB certificate/ & D.P. awarded candidates are not eligible)
- Science or science vocational with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) or Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB)
- English as compulsory subjects
- Obtained minimum **Passing marks** in PCM/PCB
- Those awaiting their 10+2 exam result this year may also apply.

5.1 Note for IB & Cambridge Candidates: Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who do not have final mark sheet will be given "Provisional Admission" based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet, before the commencement of the programme.

- 5.2 International School candidates will have to submit equivalence certificate issued by AIU to confirm their eligibility for the program as equivalent to (10+2) examination/s
- 5.3 Candidates appearing for their final 10+2 or equivalent examination can also apply provided they meet minimum cut off marks and should be eligible & produce all the necessary documents, in original, within the stipulated time.
- 5.4 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, must produce in writing from the concerned Board/University about the equivalent percentage for the GPA/ CGPA obtained.
- 5.5 Candidates of CBSE, ICSE should mention in online registration / e – admission form (if selected) 10+2 or equivalent aggregate percentage of all the subjects for which the candidate has appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven)
- 5.6 Candidates above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- 5.7 The candidate shall have passed all the subjects appeared for in the applicable examination/s. the aggregate percentage of all subjects for which the candidate has appeared will be taken into consideration for confirming eligibility of the candidate for the program at the time of admission.
- 5.8 In case the mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 5.9 Candidates passing 10+2 or equivalent from Open or Distance Learning (ODL) School recognized by National Institute of Open schooling (NIOS) can apply for the program subject to fulfilling of the eligibility criteria of the program and candidate who have passed the 10+2 of equivalent examination by doing a part-time course or through distance learning/correspondence/externally/open school other than NIOS are not eligible to apply for the program.
- 5.10. Only single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed in one attempt is Mandatory, no compartmentalized mark sheet will considered.
- 5.11 Duplicate registration will not be considered to be eligible for the programme.
- 5.12. IB Candidate has to enter ‘Predicted Score’ in case of final grades/marks are not declared. The admission will be given on provisional basis only. In case of Foreign Board, candidate has to submit AIU at the time of admission if selected.
- 5.13. In any stage if it is found that the 12th marks given by candidate in online form is

different from marks actually obtained (as per marksheet) such candidate admission will be cancelled & fees will be forfeited.

- 5.14. Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit internet copy of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college, failing which candidate will not be admitted.
- 5.15. It is sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess necessary and Requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS.

- Candidate has to ensure that demand draft should reach NMIMS, Mumbai (address as given below) till 24<sup>th</sup> June'2016.

#### **7) Selection Process:**

- Separate merit list will be prepared for Mumbai & Shirpur on the basis of 12<sup>th</sup> Science (PCM/PCB) marks filled up by the candidate at the time of online registration.
- The merit list will be put up on the NMIMS website as per important dates. The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

#### **8) Program Fees: (Subject to change)**

- Program fees for 1<sup>st</sup> year D. Pharm (Batch 2015) were 60,000/- for Mumbai Campus & Rs. 50,000/- for Shirpur Campus.

## 9) Refund Rules:

- The Schedule of refund of fees will be as follows:

1. Till the date of commencement of the Programme. (Monday 18 <sup>th</sup> July'2016)	Rs.1000/- will be deducted as administrative charges.
2. After the commencement of Programme but before the close of the admission.(From 19 <sup>th</sup> July 2016 to 23 <sup>rd</sup> July'2016)	Rs.1000 + Proportionate fees i.e. one tenth of the fees for every completed month or part thereof, if the seat vacated by the candidate is filled. If the seat remains vacant /unfilled, fees will <b>NOT</b> be refunded.
3. Cancellation after the official closure of admission. (Monday, 25 <sup>th</sup> July'2016)	Cancellation made after the official closure of Admission, fees will <b>NOT</b> be refunded.

## 10) Important instructions

- Changing of branch and campus shall not be permitted under any circumstances after admission is granted to particular branch/campus.
