4) **Eligibility Criteria & Important Instructions:**

- Candidates passing **Diploma in Pharmacy** (Post 10+2 examination) with **minimum 60% aggregate marks** from an affiliated Institute from Pharmacy Council of India.
- Those candidates who have passed Diploma in Pharmacy program from a Board/University where Grade Point Average is given, must produce in writing from the concerned Board/University about the equivalent percentage for the GPA obtained.
- Candidate will not be considered for admission process if they fail to mention/ update the aggregate score in online registration form or their result is not available during this period.
- Candidates awaiting result are not eligible to apply.
- Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their examination from overseas colleges/board.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to ensure that correct marks are entered.
- At the time of document verification, if it is found that the information given by the candidate regarding Diploma in Pharmacy score in online registration is incorrect / different than D. Pharm marks sheet, such candidate's admission will not be considered.
- Candidate above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- Duplicate registration will not be considered to be eligible for the programme.
- Only single mark sheet with all compulsory subjects taken and passed will be considered, no

compartmentalized mark sheet shall be considered.

- Candidates whose final mark sheet of the qualified examination is not available at the time of their provisional admission, is required to submit their final marksheet copy as soon as the result declared. In such case, if the candidate fail to meet the required eligibility criteria then his admission will be cancelled and the fees will be refunded as per NMIMS refund rules (even after course commencement).
- The X / XII / Diploma/ Graduation (Qualified) examination should have been conducted before the course commencement date.
- Internal / Stream Transfer will be not entertained at any reason.
- It is sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess necessary and requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS University.

5.1 Online Registration:

- a) Online Registration Fee of Rs. 2,000/- plus GST if applicable (Please refer online registration for payment details)
- b) Registration Fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE / NON-TRANSFERABLE**.
- c) Candidate has to provide two preferences compulsory from available options in the registration form.

5.2 Selection Process:

- It is mandatory to fill up all details including D. Pharm aggregate final score.

- For selection, candidate list will be prepared based on aggregate percentage of marks secured by the candidate in Diploma in Pharmacy.
- The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no enquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- If two or more candidates secure same aggregate percentage of marks in Diploma in Pharmacy, then their relative merit will be decided as per candidate securing higher aggregate percentage in 10th examination.
- Campus preferences once given in online registration will not be changed later.
- Candidates will be given admission to the program as per their merit, vacancy & availability of campus preference.
- The merit list will be put up on the NMIMS website as per important dates. The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

6. Program Fees: (Subject to change)

Program fees for 2nd year B. Pharm (lateral entry) - (Batch-2023) was Rs. 2,75,000/- (For Mumbai campus) and Rs. 1,35,000/- (For Shirpur campus).

Fees for current year i.e 2024 will be intimated at the time of admission.

7. Refund Rules:

If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission.
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission.
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission.
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally notified last of admission.
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission.

In case of (1) in the table above, the deduction will be 5% of the fees paid as processing charges from the refundable amount, subject to a maximum of Rs 5,000/-.

Note: 1) The above refund rules are subject to revision as applicable
 2) Candidates to refer Important Dates of the respective programme & refer refund rules mentioned in the offer letter.

8. Important instructions

- Candidates will be offered Campus based on the availability of seat, candidates merit rank, preferences given at the time of online registration.
- Change of campus will be considered as per preference, merit rank and availability of seat after the subsequent merit list & if admission granted to particular branch/campus till course commencement only.
- During tenure of the program changing campus shall not be permitted under any circumstances after the commencement of the program at a particular branch / campus.
- **For cancellation / withdrawal of admission:** Withdrawal / cancellation means voluntary withdrawal / cancellation by candidate for any reason. Candidate has to upload cancellation form duly filled and signed, fees paid receipt copy & cancelled cheque (personal account) to mentioned link : <https://upload.nmims.edu/admission/cancellation/>
- Please see the important dates and preserve it as a guide. All announcements from the institute will be through its web site: www.nmims.edu and no individual communication will be sent to the candidates.
- Admission to program is considered as **"Provisional Admission"** till all required and mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate and the same is verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage (even after the course commencement), admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses even if selected/ admitted to the program.
- All matters of dispute will be subject to the legal jurisdiction of Mumbai only.
- It is the sole responsibility of the candidate to check whether he/ she is eligible for the respective Program as per the eligibility criteria stated above.
- NMIMS has full right to disqualify a candidate at any stage of admission process if found ineligible. No separate intimation will be given
- Canvassing in any form for admission will disqualify the candidate.
