*Program will commence only if there are a minimum of 10 eligible candidates admitted after the selection process.

4) **Eligibility criteria for admission (Fulfilling all / applicable conditions mandatory):**

- 4.1 The candidate must have passed **10+2 or equivalent examination** including International Baccalaureate Diploma with science or science vocational with Physics, Chemistry, and Mathematics (PCM) or Physics, Chemistry and Biology (PCB) and English as compulsory subjects and obtained minimum **45% marks in (PCM / PCB)**.

For candidate of International Baccalaureate

- A) The candidate of International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB certificate / & D.P (Diploma awarded) candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered to 10+2 or equivalence examination with 24 grades/credits compulsory and has passed 3 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) plus extended essay and TOK and should have obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.
- B) DP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Boards are considered to 10 +2 or equivalence examination with 2 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and 2 subjects at Standard Level (SL) OR 3 subjects at Standard Level (SL) and 1 subject at Higher Level (HL) and should have obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.

- C) IBCP equivalence for General Strand (Arts, Commerce, Science, Law): CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 2 DP subjects with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 3 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB and should have obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.
- D) IBCP equivalence for Engineering or Medicine Strand: CP course candidates from International Baccalaureate (IB) Board are considered 3 DP subjects (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Biology or other similar subjects) with at least 1 subjects at Higher Level (HL) and minimum 03 points in each DP subject along with Career related studies with at least 03 subjects offered by IB. Further eligibility criteria as stipulated by statutory bodies like AICTE and should have obtained a minimum of 50% aggregate marks.
- 4.2 Those awaiting their 10+2 exam result this year may also apply.
- 4.3 Any State-CET score will be accepted and CET should be passed for 2025 academic year.
- 4.4 If seats remain vacant after admitting CET candidate, the Non-CET candidate will be admitted on the basis of 10+2 or equivalent examination marks of PCM / PCB.
- 4.5 Candidate of CBSE / ICSE should mention in the online registration / e-admission form (if selected) 10+2 or equivalent aggregate marks of all the subjects for which the candidate has taken & appeared for (not best of four, five, six or seven). The candidate shall have passed all the subjects taken & appeared for in the applicable examination/s.
- 4.6 In case mark sheet issued by the applicable Board / Institution is in percentile/s, the actual aggregate percentage of all the subjects appeared by the candidate will be taken into consideration.
- 4.7 **For IB & Cambridge Candidate:** Candidates called for admission on the basis of merit list & who do not have final mark sheet will be given "Provisional Admission" based on predicted scores. Fees will be accepted from such candidate but their admission will be confirmed on submission of final mark sheet if found eligible before the commencement of the programme. Mark sheet / Transcripts issued by Board / University / Institute only be considered.
- 4.8 Submission of AIU equivalence certificate to confirm the eligibility for the program is mandatory for those candidates who have completed their (10+2) examination from Overseas University.
- 4.9 Those candidates who have passed, or, are appearing for 10+2 examination from a Board / University where Grade Point Average is given, must produce in writing from the concerned Board / University about the equivalent percentage for the GPA / CGPA obtained.
- 4.10 Only single mark sheet from a single board with all compulsory subjects taken and passed will be considered, no compartmentalized mark sheet shall be considered.
- 4.11 Candidates above 25 years of age are not eligible to apply.
- 4.12 Duplicate registration will not be considered to be eligible for the programme.

- 4.13 If at any stage, it is found that a candidate does not satisfy the eligibility criteria or the information furnished by him/her in the application form is incorrect, his/her admission to the course, even if selected/ admitted, will stand cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses.
- 4.14 Candidate whose final mark sheet is not available at the time of admission are required to submit internet copy / Digi-Locker of result duly attested by Principal of the school / college with official seal, failing which, candidate will not be admitted.
- 4.15 Candidate will not be eligible if any subject is marked as ungraded/fail in the marksheet / grade-sheet. For absent / un-graded in any of the additional / non mandatory subject will be consider as eligible provided such candidate is declared as pass by respective board.
- 4.16 Admission to program is considered as **“Provisional Admission”** till all required and mandatory documents are submitted by the candidate and the same is verified and approved. If it is found that the candidate is not eligible at any stage (even after the course commencement), admission will be cancelled and fees will be refunded as per refund rule clauses even if selected / admitted to the program.
- 4.17 The XII (Qualified) examination should have been conducted before the course commencement date.
- 4.18 Mark sheet / Transcripts issued by Board / University only be considered (School / Institute will not be accepted).
- 4.19 Internal / campus Transfer will not be entertained.
- 4.20 It is sole responsibility of the candidate to ascertain whether they possess necessary and requisite qualification for admission to courses at NMIMS University.

5.1 **Online Registration:**

- a) Online Registration Fee of Rs. 2,000/- plus GST if applicable (Please refer online registration for payment details)
- b) Registration Fee is **NON-REFUNDABLE / NON-TRANSFERABLE**.
- c) Candidate has to provide two preferences compulsory from available options in the registration form.

5.2 Selection Process:

- Merit list will be prepared on the basis of CET score given by the candidate at the time of online registration.
- Preferences once given in online registration will not be changed later at any reason.
- Candidate can check their Merit / Offer status from their dashboard as per the specified in important dates. The decision of the institute will be final in this regard and no inquiries or correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- Candidates who have not appeared for CET may also apply subject to availability of seats.
- If seats remain vacant after admitting CET candidate then Non CET candidate will be admitted on the basis of 10 + 2 or equivalent exam marks of PCM / PCB & the preferences given by the candidate at the time of Online registration.

Note: Merit list for Non-CET candidates will be declared, if required & only for available vacant seats after CET admission process.

6) Program Fees for batch 2024: (for information only)

- Program fees for 1st year B. Pharm (Batch-2024) was Rs.3,00,000/- (for Mumbai campus) , Rs. 1,40,000/- (for Shirpur campus) and Rs.1,75,000/-,(for Indore Campus).
- Fees for first year B. Pharm (Batch-2025) will be declared at the time of admission.

7) Important instructions

- Candidates will be offered Campus based on the availability of seat, candidates merit rank, preferences given at the time of online registration.
- Change of campus will be considered as per preference, merit rank and availability of seat after the subsequent merit list & if admission granted to particular branch/campus till course commencement only.
- During tenure of the program changing campus shall not be permitted under any circumstances after the commencement of the program at a particular branch/campus.
- **For cancellation/withdrawal of admission:** Withdrawal / cancellation means voluntary withdrawal / cancellation by candidate for any reason. Candidate has to upload cancellation form duly filled and signed, fees paid receipt
