Refund Rules: If a student chooses to withdraw from the program of study in which he / she is enrolled, the institution concerned shall follow the following five-tier system for the refund of fees remitted by the student.

Sr. No.	Percentage of Refund of Aggregate fees*	Point of time when notice of withdrawal of admission is served to HEI
(1)	100%	15 days or more before the formally-notified last date of admission. (on & before 02nd September 2020)
(2)	90%	Less than 15 days before the formally-notified last date of admission. (3rd September to 18th September'2020)
(3)	80%	15 days or less after the formally notified last date of admission. (19th September to 3rd October'2020)
(4)	50%	30 days or less, but more than 15 days, after formally notified last of admission (4th October to 18th October'2020)
(5)	00%	More than 30 days after formally notified last date of admission. (19th October'2020 onwards)

In case of (1) in the table above, the HEI concerned shall deduct an amount not more than 5% of the fees paid by the student, subject to a maximum of Rs. 5,000/- as processing charges from the refundable amount.

Note: Candidates to refer Important Dates of the respective programme.

The above refund rules are as per University Grants Commission (UGC) notification on Refund of Fees and Non Retention of Original Certificates of October, 2018 and are subject to revision as per UGC notification (as applicable).
